DPM - India Outreach Update Ministry trip to Shillong

JANUARY 25, 2013

Dear Prayer Partners, Supporters and Friends,

Here is a report from our recent ministry trip to Shillong (N.E. India) from 9-13 January:

to find the entire arrival lobby filled in a light mist. This was quite a shock to us as we were expecting Shillong to be a little cold (the minimum temp we expected was 12°C). Driving up to Shillong on excellent roads for half the way and terrible ones for the rest, we arrived there at 11:00 p.m. to a temperature of -7°C. Exhausted as we were, we could barely sleep. As soon as it was daylight, we requested our hosts to take us to the shops and had to buy woollens to cover us from head to toe!!

We landed in Guwahati airport at about 5:45 p.m.

the first Khasi translation of Divine Exchange. We spoke very briefly about what Derek had written in this book and how it would be a blessing to every person who read it. Moksha, who helped arrange for the translation received the first copy of the book. 2) Friday 11th Jan – Morning teaching session – Call to youth

On the morning of 11th Jan we



began the teaching sessions that was open to leaders of all churches (we were told) but at least 50% of the 330 people that registered were below the age of 30. As I was led to share with the church on the "spirit of Elijah" for the end time church, I wanted to build up in the two days on the ministries of the church that it included.

So drawing from (Derek's message) "The Rod of God," I taught those that were gathered and the scripture that I came to at the end of my message was Ps. 110:3 and we were led in the Spirit to challenge the youth to arise and make a commitment – at least half the room was up front to pray that the spirit of God would empower them to function in the spirit and power of Elijah in these last days. Now, the amazing thing was that God had worked in the natural before this

happened - the scripture - Ps. 110:3, talks about dew - that morning for the first time in many, many years, Upper Shillong had received snowfall! We truly believe that God is raising up the young generation for a great revival in India - the sound of yet another trumpet here!! 3) Saturday 12th Jan – Morning teaching session – Leaders




